The following notation ruling by Commissioner Jennifer Koh of the Court was entered on March 11, 2022, regarding Respondent's Motion for Extension of Time to File Respondent's Brief until March 18, 2022:

On March 1, 2022, Respondents filed their fifth motion for extension of time to file their brief, citing counsel's work responsibilities on an apparently unrelated matter in superior court. On the same day, Appellant filed an objection, noting, among other things, that counsel's workload responsibilities do not appear to constitute good cause for an extension, particularly in light of the significant delay since the filing of the opening brief. The objection appears well-taken and Respondents did not file a reply.

Accordingly, the motion to extend time is granted in part, to March 15, 2022. If Respondent does not file the brief by 5:00 p.m. on March 15, 2022, sanctions of \$250 may be imposed against counsel without further notice.
